ISO 14001 – EMS (Environmental Management Systems)

All companies should be embedding the environment into their business. An environmental management system (EMS) helps to understand & actively manage environmental impacts, costs, risks & legislation. This is done in a structured, organised manner.

With nearly 350,000 certificates issued across the world, **ISO 14001** is the best known standard. You do not have to go through formal certification, but use it as a basis for your EMS.

The cyclic process of ISO 14001, shown here, leads to continuous improvement. More details of each stage are given overleaf.

Value - Drivers & Benefits

Organisations start out on this for a variety of reasons:

• **Customer expectation** – Customers now expect suppliers to demonstrate commitment to their own values. Often, through tender documents, they will ask for carbon footprint data, policy or ISO 14001 certificate.

• **Competitive edge** – Showing how their EMS makes them better than their competitors.

• Legal requirements – They may come under legal reporting requirements, be on the Environment Agency's radar or are simply aware of the range of legislation that applies to them.

• **Cost savings** – With ever increasing costs and pressures on the bottom line, organisations welcome the fact that it can be used to find efficiencies and savings.



Your EMS and ISO 14001:2015

There is a new version of ISO 14001 & the deadline for adapting your existing EMS to this is **September 2018**. There are some <u>significant changes</u> so a Gap Analysis is needed to identify where your existing system needs attention. I can help you with your transition to the requirements of the new standard.

Certification

Eshcon does not carry out the certification itself, but I can recommend bodies that do, such as NQA or SGS. ISO 14001 certification is valid for 3 years, though companies are audited on a yearly basis. Here is more information on the <u>certification</u> <u>process</u>.




